

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the workshop will be to present the set of candidate alternatives that will be carried forward for further study in the Draft Environmental Impact Statement as required in the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Interested citizens and organizations will be able to comment on the proposed alternatives. Several members of the study team, which includes the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the National Park Service (NPS), and the study consultant (Parsons), will be present to answer any questions you may have. The meeting will include an open workshop followed by a brief presentation and an informal question and answer session. Maps of the proposed alternatives, information on preliminary impacts, and other materials will also be provided at the workshop. In compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties eligible or listed in the National Register of Historic Places will be available at the hearing. There will also be an opportunity for interested citizens or groups to sign up as consulting parties to the Section 106 process.
